Accommodations:

Fifty-five (55) hotel rooms will be provided to Idaho attendees at THE COEUR D’ALENE for one night. You must be traveling at least 100 miles to the Summit to be eligible for a room. To maximize the number of attendees, we strongly encourage you to room share with those from your same agency (two queen beds). Rooms will be reserved for up to two (2) participants from each agency on a first-come, first-serve basis. If you plan to stay an additional night or if the 55 rooms are full, you are responsible for making the reservation and paying the room fee to the hotel directly.

Transportation:

If you are an overnight guest, hotel parking is \$18 per night. There is a day rate at the garage for non-hotel guests. There is also an open free parking lot just west of the hotel off of Northwest Blvd. and N. Idaho Centennial Trail at Independence Point Park.

The nearest commercial airport is located 40 mi. west of Coeur d’Alene in Spokane. If needed, a shuttle from the airport to the hotel is available which must be arranged 24 hours in advance by contacting 800-688-75253 x7133 or completing an [online form](#). Round trip shuttle is \$69 per person.
