

Projects in Design/Development (Updated Quarterly)

Old Hwy 37, The Narrows, Sponsor: Oneida County Key # 9894

Description: This Old HWY 37, The Narrows roadway improvement portion of the project involves improving and/or realigning the 3.7-mile section of Old Highway 37 that is currently situated within Rock Creek Canyon. The existing roadway in the canyon is a narrow two-lane road with minimal or no shoulders, numerous substandard curves, steep embankments, flooding and undercutting of the roadway by Rock Creek and rock fall are persistent problems which will be addressed and improved as part of this project.

Status: Approved environmental document has been received. Hydraulic report has been submitted and is in approval stages. Design Study Report has been approved. Final design plans anticipated in September.

E Oneida Street Reconstruction, Sponsor: Franklin County Key # 11244

Description: This project was intended to reconstruct and widen 2.781 miles of existing roadway. Due to funding constraints, 0.75 miles of roadway will be improved creating better sight distance over the hollows. The project includes an urban portion in the City of Preston and a rural portion in the county, creating a city and county partnership. Two crossings of Worm Creek will have vertical sight distance improvements.

Status: Consultant has revised the final plans and specifications based on evaluation of the bids received. LHTAC is currently reviewing the latest plans. Anticipate re-bidding project in October.

Groveland Rd: SH39 to US26/Pioneer Rd, Sponsor: Bingham County Key # 12445

Description: This project will improve a critical intersection with poor sight distance west of Blackfoot, ID. Groveland Road will be realigned to intersect with US 26.

Status: Final design review meeting was held. Consultant is addressing the comments and will work on the PS&E package. Waiting on canal company structure design.

Benton St Bridge, Sponsor: City of Pocatello Key # 13119

Description: This project consists of rehabilitating Benton St. Bridge with fiber wrap of columns and repairing the pier caps. An impressed current cathodic protection system is going to be used for corrosion mitigation.

Status: This project has been advertised. Pre-bid meeting was held in Pocatello on June 28th. Bid opens on July 11th.

Fisher Ave - E Walker St to Bridge St, Sponsor: City of Blackfoot Key # 19247

Description: Fisher Street is an urban arterial and this project includes improving 0.89 miles of it with new curb, gutter, sidewalks, and drainage between Alice and Walker Streets.

Status: This project is in the ITIP and currently scheduled under Preliminary Development. It is waiting for design funding currently programmed for FY20.

Bannock St Reconstruction, Malad City, Sponsor: City of Malad Key # 19622

Description: This project includes reconstructing 0.7 miles of Bannock Street, which runs through the center of the city. A major water system upgrade in the recent past has left this route with many utility patches. The roadway needs a complete reconstruction to reestablish a proper pavement section.

Status: This project is in the ITIP and currently scheduled for design in FY18 and for construction in FY21.
