Cove Rd Bridge, Washington Co, Sponsor: Washington County Key # 19129

Description: This project is for work to replace the 3-span steel truss bridge on Cove Road over the Weiser River with a 2-span steel girder bridge, and raise the approach grades.

Status: Draft Concept Report and draft Materials Report are currently being reviewed.

Horseshoe Pk Path & SW Ave Impr, Sponsor: City of New Plymouth Key # 19966

Description: The purpose of the project is to add safe pedestrian and bicycle facilities in Horseshoe Park (Southwest Blvd.) between S. Plymouth Ave. and Southwest Ave. and on the south side of Southwest Ave. beginning at S. Plymouth Ave. and ending at SW 1st Ave. near the west city limits boundary.

Status: This project is currently developing Preliminary Design Plans and working on the Environmental Document.

Description: This project will develop plans and specifications for the intersection alignment, pavement maintenance or pavement rehabilitation services. It will replace a functionally obsolete one-lane bridge. The project may include minor widening and right-of-way acquisition.

Status: This project is currently in Final Design and in the process of right-of-way acquisition. Design Approval was granted on 3-13-2018.

Old Hwy 30/Plymouth St Bridge Replacement, Sponsor: Canyon HD Key # 13494

Description: This project will construct a new bridge at a new location. The existing bridge will be left in place to serve pedestrians and bicyclists and provide connectivity for the City of Caldwell's Greenbelt pathway. The project includes two canal crossings and approximately 2200 feet of new approach roadway construction.

Description: This project will construct a nearly half-mile long 10-foot wide multiple-use asphalt and concrete pathway along Indian Creek, build two (2) pedestrian bridges over Indian Creek, build a crosswalk over Simplot Blvd., and construct lighting along the entire pathway system.

Description: This project will improve the sight distances for the safety of motorists. This section of roadway includes improving safety features within five steep grades located between M.P. 100.8 to M.P. 104.1. Blasting is to improve the vertical and horizontal alignment of the road. The roadway will be constructed back to the existing gravel section.

Improvements include a traffic signal, pedestrian facilities, street lighting, lane widening and the installation of turn lanes.

The project will also provide for safety and ADA improvements to the crosswalk where Indian Creek Pathway crosses South Kings Road, including Rapid Flashing Beacons (RFB), street lighting, ADA pedestrian ramps, sidewalk/stormwater system repair, thermoplastic striping and signage.
