E Oneida Street Reconstruction, Sponsor: Franklin County Key # 11244

Description: This project will reconstruct and widen 0.75 miles of existing roadway creating better sight distance through the hollows. The project includes an urban portion in the City of Preston and a rural portion in the county, creating a city

and county partnership. Two crossings of Worm Creek will have vertical sight distance improvements.

Status: Project rebids opened 3/13/18. Currently working with Sponsor to justify the 24% over estimate bid results.

American Falls Pedestrian Connectivity, Sponsor: City of American Falls Key # 19841

Description: The American Falls Bicycle/Pedestrian Connectivity Project includes Bannock Avenue from Lee Street to Madison Street, Bannock Avenue from Harrison Street to Roosevelt Street and Roosevelt Street from Bannock Avenue to Tyhee Avenue. The project is located in the City of American Falls, south of the Hwy 39 bypass, in Power County. Status: The Project is currently waiting on Final Permits and the City has the PS&E Submittal and is awaiting approval to

Bannock St Reconstruction, Malad City, Sponsor: City of Malad Key # 19622

Description: This project includes reconstructing 0.7 miles of Bannock Street, which runs through the center of the city. A major water system upgrade in the recent past has left this route with many utility patches. The roadway needs a complete reconstruction to reestablish a proper pavement section.

Status: Design consultant has been selected and under contract. Project is waiting to be kicked off soon.

Center Street Railroad Bridge Underpass Rehab, Sponsor: City of Pocatello Key # 12098

Description: Center Street is depressed under the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) tracks in Pocatello, ID. The project improvements are intended to keep the bridge in service for a period of approximately 40 years by repairing and preserving the abutments, replacing the fascia and the portals to the sidewalks, and replacing the retaining walls and sidewalks leading to the undercrossing. Existing roadway and pedestrian lighting at the underpass and along the approach walkways will be upgraded.

Status: Arranging project meeting to discuss preliminary design. Concept Approval was December 2013.
