

Projects in Design/Development (Updated Quarterly)

Yale Road Stage 4; MP 12.1 to 13.7, Sponsor: Burley HD Key # 19637

Description: This project includes improvement to Yale Road from MP 12.1 to MP 13.7. The two miles of pavement rehabilitation and realignment include: 1) Roadway ballast to support the increased heavy truck traffic associated with the farm to market operations, 2) Improved horizontal and vertical alignment by removing substandard curves, stop conditions, 90° curves and improve sight distance and overall safety, 3) Widened road and shoulders to meet AASHTO standards and allow for safe passage of vehicles 4) Improve shoulder slopes, ditches, and drainage structures to improve the drainage system.

Status: Project has been kicked off. Topographical survey and geotechnical investigation have been completed. Held public meeting for property owners input. Materials phase reports and charter report are being developed.

Idahome Rd and 2750 E Rd, Sponsor: Raft River HD Key # 20312

Description: This project is funded through the Freight Program and is to improve approximately 4.2 miles of rural collector roadway by reconstructing and paving. The improvements shall begin at the I-84/Idahome Road Interchange and extend along Idahome Road to the intersection with 2750 E Road then north along 2750 E Road to the north end of the EVC Dairy Operation. The roadway improvements shall be designed for 129,000 lb. vehicles.

Status: Concept/Charter Approved 4/25/2018. Materials Reports have been submitted and are in process of approval. Preliminary Design was submitted 6/8/2018. Comments submitted 6/27/2018.

West Glendale Road & Canal Bridge, Sponsor: Blaine County Key # 13998

Description: This project includes upgrading the roadway from .7 miles west of State Highway 75 to Glendale Canal. The project includes replacing structurally deficient Glendale Canal Bridge.

Status: This project is currently in Preliminary Design and preparing the environmental document.

1700 S Rd Bridge, Sponsor: Gooding HD Key # 18973

Description: The 1700 South Road Bridge has a sufficiency rating of 30.9 and is planned to be replaced. The bridge has a 90-degree skew that makes it very dangerous for motorists and trucks trying to travel over the bridge. The replacement structure is anticipated to be a 120-foot, single span, precast concrete girder bridge. The proposed 34-foot bridge width will accommodate two 12-foot lanes and 2-foot shoulders. An existing overflow culvert east of the bridge will be replaced with the roadway improvement. The roadway horizontal and vertical alignment will be designed to improve operation and safety to accommodate a 45 mph driving speed and meet hydraulic clearance requirements. A total of 1100 feet of 1700 South Road will be redesigned with the proposed bridge.

Status: The project is currently developing Preliminary Design Plans and working on the Environmental Document.

Description: This project includes reconstructing 1.15 miles of the roadway while upgrading the base, widening the pavement, and evaluate installing left turn lanes.

Description: This joint project, sponsored by Oakley Highway District and Murtaugh Highway District, includes rehabilitating Golden Valley Road from MP 6 to MP 12. This consists of approximately 6 miles of roadway rehabilitation starting at the intersection of 1500 W Road and Golden Valley Road and continuing east to the intersection 900 W and Golden Valley Road. The project consists of approximately 2 miles of overlay, 2 miles of Recycled Asphalt Base Stabilization (RABS) rehabilitation, and chip sealing the entire 6 miles of roadway.

4100 N Rehabilitation; 2100 E to 2400 E, Sponsor: Filer HD Key # 19672

Description: This project includes rehabilitating the existing 4100 North Road from 2100 E to 2400 E. The highway district is being proactive before the roadway further deteriorates and causes an emergency. The rehabilitation project plans to use a Cement Recycled Asphalt Base Stabilization (CRABS) rehabilitation process to rehabilitate this road and prepare it for the expected traffic volumes.

Status: The contract scope of work and estimate have been negotiated and the agreement is being prepared for signature and approval.

E 4100 N Rehabilitation Phase 2, Sponsor: Buhl HD Key # 20518

Description: This project will rehabilitate and widen E 41-- road from N 1730 E in Buhl Highway District to N 2100 E in Filer Highway District. The intent is to recycle the existing asphalt (CRABS) and utilize the recycled material to build the new widened base of the typical section. The roadway will receive an asphalt overlay, new striping, and rumble strips to alert drivers if they drift outside their lane. This project is in two highway jurisdictions.

Status: This project is in the ITIP and currently scheduled under Preliminary Development. It is waiting for design funding currently. The State/Local agreement has been sent to the sponsor and is currently waiting for a signature.

Description: This project consists of rehabilitation of 5.4 miles of Shoe String Road in Gooding County. The rehabilitation is needed to improve the deteriorating roadway surface and the safety of the corridor. The project is anticipated to be a combination of rehabilitation efforts including reconstruction, asphalt overlays, crack/chip sealing, and shoulder improvements. The existing roadway has an asphalt surface in poor condition that is 24 ft wide with narrow gravel shoulders. The project proposes widening the Shoe String Road asphalt surface to 26 ft and adding wider gravel shoulders.
