

Projects in Design/Development (Updated Quarterly)

Center Street Railroad Bridge Underpass Rehab, Sponsor: City of Pocatello Key # 12098

Description: Center Street is depressed under the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) tracks in Pocatello, ID. The project improvements are intended to keep the bridge in service for a period of approximately 40 years by repairing and preserving the abutments, replacing the fascia and the portals to the sidewalks, and replacing the retaining walls and sidewalks leading to the undercrossing. Existing roadway and pedestrian lighting at the underpass and along the approach walkways will be upgraded. A pedestrian bridge over Center Street is part of the project.

Status: Final plans have been submitted. City is working on the State Local Agreement for construction. Waiting for construction funding and final railroad permit.

Int Hawthorne & W Quinn Rds, Sponsor: City of Pocatello Key # 12099

Description: This project will make improvements to the intersection of Hawthorne and Quinn Road. The project will complete roadway improvements at the intersection and install a new traffic signal: New ROW will be required.

Status: This project's Plans, Specifications, and Estimate (PS&E) package has been received. The City is working on the State Local Agreement for Construction. The project is waiting for construction funding.

Description: This project includes reconstructing 0.7 miles of Bannock Street, which runs through the center of the city. A major water system upgrade in the recent past has left this route with many utility patches. The roadway needs a complete reconstruction to reestablish a proper pavement section.

Status: Environmental document still being reviewed and waiting for approval.

Description: The N Beach Road; US-89 to Dingle E Shore Road Pavement Markings/Delineators project is located near the City of St Charles in Bear Lake County and will improve the roadway network safety with the installation of new, permanent edgeline markings, centerline markings, and delineators to reduce/eliminate serious injury crashes and fatalities.

Status: Preliminary design completed. Logical termini for this project has been redefined. Additional environmental work is needed to complete the Environmental Document.

Description: The scope of the S 5th Avenue Safety Improvements project, located in the City of Pocatello, will be accomplished by installing a raised median on 5th Ave from I-15 to Jason Ave, crosswalk on 5th Ave, a rectangular rapid flashing beacon (RRFB) to aid the crosswalk, a sidewalk system on the east side of 5th Ave, Upgrade and improve signing and ADA compliant wheelchair ramps at the four corners of 5th Ave/Jason Ave.

Status: The Project is currently waiting on Final Permits and Plan, Specifications, and Estimate (PS&E) Submittal to obligate funds.
