

Projects in Design/Development (Updated Quarterly)

Mountain View Rd, Moscow, Sponsor: City of Moscow Key # 13014

Description: This project will widen an existing 24' wide two-lane rural road section to a 36' wide two-lane urban road with bicycle lanes, turn lanes, storm drainage improvements, illumination, curbs, gutter, sidewalks, and a roundabout at the intersection of Mountain View Road and 6th Street.

Status: The Final PS&E has been received and waiting for construction funding.

STC-4715, Clear Creek Bridge, Sponsor: Idaho County Key # 13445

Description: This project consists of replacing a 50 year old bridge which serves as an access point to hundreds of residents, several businesses, recreation, and agricultural uses. It is the primary access point to the Nez Perce Tribe's Clear Creek Fish Hatchery. If the bridge were to fail, a substantial detour of over 20 miles through mountainous terrain with steep slopes would be required. This is a vital transportation asset for Idaho County.

Status: This project is currently in the bidding process with bid opening schedule for March 2, 2021.

Beech/Chestnut St Reconstruction, Sponsor: City of Genesee Key # 18770

Description: This project reconstructs Chestnut Street from Jackson Street to Cedar Street, and Beech Street from Chestnut Street to Hazel Avenue. Improvements will include turn lanes, bike lanes, sidewalks, stormwater system repairs, lighting and landscape enhancements.

Status: The final design package has been submitted. The final design review will take place in February. The Environmental Evaluation was approved on 12/26/2021. The consultant is working on finalizing property use agreements for adjacent properties.

Description: This project will make improvements to this corridor with the installation of ADA compliant curb extensions to reduce the pedestrian crossing length and improve pedestrian visibility. Additionally the project will include the improvement of pedestrian ramps and crosswalks to eliminate gaps in the ADA compliant corridor connecting the University of Idaho to the central business district and high-density residential.

Description: The Old Ahsahka Grade Guardrail project, located near the City of Ahsahka in Clearwater County, will install roughly 7,000 feet of steel post guardrail adjacent to the steepest embankments. This will help eliminate run off the road possibilities along this 2.5 Mile section of roadway and reduce/eliminate fatal and serious injury crashes for all roadway users.

Status: This project had Preliminary Design submitted in December 2020. Currently work is being done to complete the Environmental Document.

Description: The Third Street Corridor Safety Improvement Phase 2 project, located in the City of Moscow in Latah County, will remove and replace concrete sidewalk, upgrade ADA pedestrian ramps, install curb and gutter, install LED Luminaries and install four high visibility thermoplastic crosswalks to reduce/eliminate fatal and serious injury accidents for all roadway users.

Description: The INT 21st Street & 19th Avenue Signal project, located in the City of Lewiston in Nez Perce County, will install safety improvements which include; widening the eastbound leg of 19th Avenue, widening the northbound leg of 21st Street, reconfiguration of the westbound leg of 19th Avenue, improvements to the signal phasing and timing, addition of advanced video detection and construction of ADA compliant pedestrian crossings. These improvements will help to reduce/eliminate fatal and serious injury accidents for all roadway users.

Status: Final Design Review for this project is complete. The Consultant is working on revisions to prepare the Plan, Specifications, and Estimate (PS&E) Submittal. This submittal should occur in March 2021.

Thain Rd; Stewart to Cedar, Sponsor: City of Lewiston Key # 22075

Description: This project begins at the top of Thain Grade at the signalized intersection of Thain Rd and Stewart Ave and continues southeast to the 2-way stop controlled intersection of Thain Rd and Cedar Ave. Intersections designated for improvement are Stewart Av (signal), Vista (2-way stop), Preston Ave (2-way stop), Warner Ave (1-way stop), Airway Ave (1-way stop), Burrell Ave (signal) and Cedar Ave (2-way stop). Project scope includes construction of pedestrian curb ramps at 7 intersections totaling 22 ramps & 3 islands with 8 additional ramps; installation of bicycle detection, sharrow marking and signing at signalized intersections of Stewart & Burrell; and necessary removal and relocation of marked crosswalks.

Status: This project has been awarded and construction is anticipated to begin in March 2021.
