 - Is Located between Mountain Home and Sun Valley
 - Is 1079 Square Miles
 - 64.68 % is Federal Land
 - 3.6 % State Lands
 - 31.72 Private Lands

Camas County Road and Bridge

- Camas County
 - Maintains 410 Miles of Road
 - 21 Miles are Paved
 - 75 Miles are USFS Roads & are Closed During the Winter

- Camas County
 - Has 44 Bridges
 - 22 – Under 20 Feet
 - 24 – Over 20 Feet
 - 26 Bridges are Timber – Constructed in 1960s and 1970s
 - 2 Thru Trusses
 - 8 have been Replaced Since 1998
