The tunnel is closed for the winter, but typically opens by May 10th to accommodate traffic. There are not any detour options.

Laila Kral noted that this is the access to the Hiawatha Trail, which is estimated to bring in \$20M in tourism.

Discussion: Will the work get the tunnel open for summer if this is funded? Laila noted that they are planning on getting it opened by mid-May.

Motion by Member Gier. Motion: To approve Shoshone County's application for \$100,000 as presented. Seconded by Member Lampert. Motion passes
