

## **District 2 Projects in Design Phase**

### **Quarterly Update April through June 2022**

#### **Snake River Avenue; Southway Br to 11th Ave, Sponsor: City of Lewiston, Key #: 13443**

**Description:** This project will widen and resurface Snake River Ave. in Lewiston from Southway Bridge to 11th Ave. Also curbs, gutters, sidewalks, storm drainages, and utility adjustments will all be provided. This project is located on SMA-7014 between mile points 1.9 and 2.9.

**Status:** The Consultant is currently developing Preliminary Design Plans and working on the Environmental document.

#### **9th St Grade; 5th Avenue to Idaho St, Sponsor: City of Lewiston, Key #: 18938**

**Description:** This project will reconstruct the 9th St. Grade roadway, retaining wall, and elevated sidewalk from 5th Ave. to Idaho St.. The current roadway and pedestrian railing do not meet AASHTO guidelines as they relate to roadway design, curvature, superelevation, guardrail, and pedestrian protection. This project is located on SMA-7134 between mile points 1.973 and 2.180.

**Status:** This project is in the Idaho Transportation Investment Program (ITIP) and currently scheduled under Preliminary Development. We are currently waiting for design funding.

#### **Bryden Ave Reconstruction, Stage 1, Sponsor: City of Lewiston, Key #: 20024**

**Description:** This project will reconstruct Bryden Ave. from 4th St. to 7th St. This project is located on SMA-7344 from mile points 0 to 0.245 and 1.008 to 1.507.

**Status:** This project is in the Idaho Transportation Investment Program (ITIP) and currently scheduled for construction in FY2029 or after. Design funding is currently programmed for FY2022.

#### **Old Ahsahka Grade, Sponsor: Clearwater County, Key #: 21996**

**Description:** The Old Ahsahka Grade Guardrail project, located near the City of Ahsahka in Clearwater County, will install roughly 7,000 feet of steel post guardrail adjacent to the steepest embankments. This will help eliminate run off the road possibilities along this 2.5-mile section of roadway and reduce/eliminate fatal and serious injury crashes for all roadway users.

**Status:** The consultant has submitted the project Plan, Specifications, and Estimate (PS&E) package to LHTAC. Project will be bidding soon.

### **Quarterly Update April through June 2022**

#### **Public Ave Corridor Safety Improvement, Sponsor: City of Moscow, Key #: 22402**

**Description:** The scope of the Public Ave; Polk St to Orchard Ave Improvements project, located in the City of Moscow, will be accomplished by constructing a concrete splitter island, upgrade the road section, install curb, gutter, and sidewalk, and widen the roadway to eliminate roadside ditches.

**Status:** The Consultant is currently developing Preliminary Design Plans and working on the Environmental Document.

#### **Lake Road Safety Improvements, Sponsor: Grangeville HD, Key #: 22404**

**Description:** Construction of the Signing and Guardrail project will install LED flashing Ice signs, curve ahead signs, as well as intersection ahead signs at poor visibility locations. Additionally, this project will help prevent slide-offs by installing guardrail along those roads that steep narrow and winding.

**Status:** The consultant has submitted the project Plan, Specifications, and Estimate (PS&E) package to LHTAC. LHTAC is still waiting on the 404 Permit.

### **Mountain View Rd, Moscow, Sponsor: City of Moscow, Key #: 13014**

**Description:** This project will widen an existing 24' wide two-lane rural road section to a 36' wide two-lane urban road with bicycle lanes, turn lanes, storm drainage improvements, illumination, curbs, gutter, sidewalks, and a roundabout at the intersection of Mountain View Road and 6th Street.

**Status:** This project is currently in construction and approximately 10% complete. The anticipated completion date is in September 2022.

### **STC-4715, Clear Creek Bridge, Sponsor: Idaho County, Key #: 13445**

**Description:** This project consists of replacing a 50 year old bridge which serves as an access point to hundreds of residents, several businesses, recreation, and agricultural uses. It is the primary access point to the Nez Perce Tribe's Clear Creek Fish Hatchery. If the bridge were to fail, a substantial detour of over 20 miles through mountainous terrain with steep slopes would be required.

**Status:** The project is currently in construction and about 75% complete. The anticipated completion date is in June 2022.

### **Beech/Chestnut St Reconstruction, Sponsor: City of Genesee, Key #: 18770**

**Description:** This project reconstructs Chestnut Street from Jackson Street to Cedar Street, and Beech Street from Chestnut Street to Hazel Avenue. Improvements will include turn lanes, bike lanes, sidewalks, stormwater system repairs, lighting and landscape enhancements.

**Status:** The project is currently in construction and approximately 10% complete. The anticipated completion date is in September 2022.

### **6th St Ped Imprv, Sponsor: City of Moscow, Key #: 20109**

**Description:** This project will make improvements to this corridor with the installation of ADA compliant curb extensions to reduce the pedestrian crossing length and improve pedestrian visibility. Additionally the project will include the improvement of pedestrian ramps and crosswalks to eliminate gaps in the ADA compliant corridor connecting the University of Idaho to the central business district and high-density residential.

**Status:** The project is currently in Construction. The anticipated completion date is August 2022.

### **3rd St Safety Imprv Ph1, Sponsor: City of Moscow, Key #: 20483**

**Description:** The Third Street (SH-8) Safety Improvements Phase 1 project, located in the City of Moscow in Latah County, will improve pedestrian/bike safety with the replacement of curb, pedestrian ramps and sidewalk along with the installation of additional roadway lighting to reduce/eliminate serious injury crashes and fatalities.

**Status:** The project is currently in Construction. The anticipated completion date is August 2022.

### **3rd St Safety Imprv Phase 2, Sponsor: City of Moscow, Key #: 21997**

**Description:** The Third Street Corridor Safety Improvement Phase 2 project, located in the City of Moscow in Latah County, will remove and replace concrete sidewalk, upgrade ADA pedestrian ramps, install curb and gutter, install LED streetlights and install four high visibility thermoplastic crosswalks to reduce/eliminate fatal and serious injury accidents for all roadway users.

**Status:** The project is currently in Construction. The anticipated completion date is August 2022.

### **Cherrylane Bridge Construction, Sponsor: Nez Perce County, Key #: 22638**
