Snake River Avenue; Southway Br to 11th Ave, Sponsor: City of Lewiston, Key Number: 13443

Description: This project is to widen and resurface Snake River Avenue in Lewiston from Southway Bridge to 11th Avenue. Curbs, gutters, sidewalks, storm drains, and utility adjustments will also be provided. This project is located on Snake River Avenue (SMA-7014) between mile points 1.9 and 2.9.

Status: The design consultant is currently working to update the Right-of-Way (ROW) plans and the draft Plans, Specifications, & Estimate (PS&E) submittal. ITD will work to negotiate ROW acquisition on behalf of the city once updated ROW plans are received. All parties are aware of schedule constraints to obligate Fiscal Year 2025 construction funding.

Public Ave Corridor Safety Improvement, Sponsor: City of Moscow, Key Number: 22402

Description: The scope of the Public Avenue; Polk Street to Orchard Avenue Improvements project, located in the City of Moscow, will be accomplished by constructing a concrete splitter island, upgrading the road section, installing curb, gutter, and sidewalk, and widening the roadway to eliminate roadside ditches.

Status: The project bids received exceeded the Engineer's estimate by more than ten percent. Justification of award to the Apparent Low Bidder was approved at the April 2025 ITD Board meeting. Contract will move forward with award.
