

# COMPLETION TIMELINE

Each person has four (4) years to complete the course requirements for either the Road Scholar or Road Master programs. Certain courses expire before the four (4) year deadline:

- Flagging (Three Years)
- First Aid (Two Years)
- CPR (Two Years)

**All courses must be current upon completion of the programs.**

Students may take courses for the programs at the same time. As long as courses remain current, students can receive both certifications at the same time.
